## PSALMS OF THE ASCENT - 132

### NOTES | 10.30.22

#### Psalm 132 English Standard Version (ESV)

#### A Song of Ascents.

Remember, O Lord, in David's favor,  
all the hardships he endured,  
how he swore to the Lord  
and vowed to the Mighty One of Jacob,  
"I will not enter my house  
or get into my bed,  
I will not give sleep to my eyes  
or slumber to my eyelids,  
until I find a place for the Lord,  
a dwelling place for the Mighty One of Jacob."  
Behold, we heard of it in Ephrathah;  
we found it in the fields of Jaar.  
"Let us go to his dwelling place;  
let us worship at his footstool!"

Arise, O Lord, and go to your resting place,  
you and the ark of your might.  
Let your priests be clothed with righteousness,  
and let your saints shout for joy.  
For the sake of your servant David,  
do not turn away the face of your anointed one.

The Lord swore to David a sure oath  
from which he will not turn back:  
“One of the sons of your body[a]  
I will set on your throne.  
If your sons keep my covenant  
and my testimonies that I shall teach them,  
their sons also forever  
shall sit on your throne.”

For the Lord has chosen Zion;  
he has desired it for his dwelling place:  
“This is my resting place forever;  
here I will dwell, for I have desired it.  
I will abundantly bless her provisions;  
I will satisfy her poor with bread.  
Her priests I will clothe with salvation,  
and her saints will shout for joy.  
There I will make a horn to sprout for David;  
I have prepared a lamp for my anointed.  
His enemies I will clothe with shame,  
but on him his crown will shine.”

## **2 Samuel 7:1-16 | ESV**

Now when the king lived in his house and the Lord had given him rest from all his surrounding enemies, the king said to Nathan the prophet, “See now, I dwell in a house of cedar, but the ark of God dwells in a tent.” And Nathan said to the king, “Go, do all that is in your heart, for the Lord is with you.”

But that same night the word of the Lord came to Nathan, “Go and tell my servant David,

‘Thus says the Lord: Would you build me a house to dwell in? I have not lived in a house since the day I brought up the people of Israel from Egypt to this day, but I have been moving about in a tent for my dwelling. In all places where I have moved with all the people of Israel, did I speak a word with any of the judges of Israel, whom I commanded to shepherd my people Israel, saying, “Why have you not built me a house of cedar?” Now, therefore, thus you shall say to my servant David, ‘Thus says the Lord of hosts, I took you from the pasture, from following the sheep, that you should be prince over my people Israel. And I have been with you wherever you went and have cut off all your enemies from before you. And I will make for you a great name, like the name of the great ones of the earth. And I will appoint a place for my people Israel and will plant them, so that they may dwell in their own place and be disturbed no more. And violent men shall afflict them no more, as formerly, from the time that I appointed judges over my people Israel. And I will give you rest from all your enemies. Moreover, the Lord declares to you that the Lord will make you a house. When your days are fulfilled and you lie down with your fathers, I will raise up your offspring after you, who shall come from your body, and I will establish his kingdom. He shall build a house for my name, and I will establish the throne of his kingdom forever. I will be to him a father, and he shall be to me a son. When he commits iniquity, I will discipline him with the rod of men, with the stripes of the sons of men, but my steadfast love will not depart from him, as I took it from Saul, whom I put away from before you. And your house and your kingdom shall be made sure forever before me. Your throne shall be established forever.’”

### **Luke 1:26-33 | ESV**

In the sixth month the angel Gabriel was sent from God to a city of Galilee named Nazareth, to a virgin betrothed to a man whose name was Joseph, of the house of David. And the virgin’s name was Mary. And he came to her and said, “Greetings, O favored one, the Lord is with you!” But she was greatly troubled at the saying, and tried to discern what sort of greeting this might be. And the angel said to her, “Do not be afraid, Mary, for you have found favor with God. And behold, you will conceive in your womb and bear a son, and you shall call his name Jesus. He will be great and will be called the Son of the Most High. And the Lord God will give to him the throne of his father David, and he will reign over the house of Jacob forever, and of his kingdom there will be no end.”

### **1 Peter 2:4-5 | ESV**

As you come to him, a living stone rejected by men but in the sight of God chosen and precious, you yourselves like living stones are being built up as a spiritual house, to be a holy priesthood, to offer spiritual sacrifices acceptable to God through Jesus Christ.
