BEST SERMON EVER – SALT AND LIGHT

NOTES | 6.06.21

Matthew 5:13–16 English Standard Version (ESV)

“You are the salt of the earth, but if salt has lost its taste, how shall its saltiness be restored? It is no longer good for anything except to be thrown out and trampled under people’s feet.

“You are the light of the world. A city set on a hill cannot be hidden. Nor do people light a lamp and put it under a basket, but on a stand, and it gives light to all in the house. In the same way, let your light shine before others, so that they may see your good works and give glory to your Father who is in heaven.”

IMPLICATIONS

1. **We are infinitely valuable. We will experience true freedom and peace when we live in our value, not our lies.**
2. **As followers of Jesus, we are called to bring light into dark places by calling out the true identity of others from God's perspective.**
3. **We should stick out, but for good reasons, not bad.**
